





Greenwich, from day one





The world within reach


The apartments are located in Zone 2 and moments away from the nearest Underground station, North Greenwich. Getting to Canary Wharf on the Jubilee Line takes approximately 10 minutes, while Westminster is 14 minutes away.

Excellent rail links come courtesy of nearby Greenwich station, which enjoys fast links to London Victoria, Charing Cross and London Bridge. Thameslink also provides a fast and direct link to Luton Airport.

Greenwich station is also on the Dockland Light Railway route which serves the Docklands business district and the City of London. London City Airport is also within easy reach.

For more unconventional methods of getting around, look to the UK's only cable car ride, taking you from Greenwich Peninsula to the Royal Docks.


STRONG GROWTH
